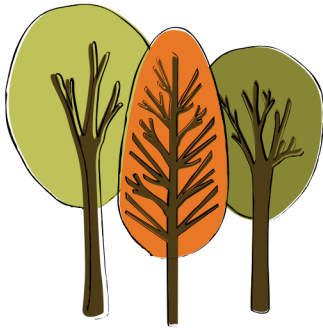




NEW ENGLAND FALL FOLIAGE
